Wishing you all a joyful and restful Thanksgiving season. I'm truly thankful for each of you.



Fall Bocce Tournament Winners







Our Fall Bocce Tournament was a huge, huge success! The energy, excitement, and friendly competition made it one of the highlights of the season here at Sterling Estates.
